Both <i>En Bateau</i> and the <i>Cortège</i> are settings of poems by Debussy's favourite poet, Paul Verlaine. The final movement – <i>Ballet</i> – rounds things off with an energetic dance. The work is in three parts with the slow middle section including the famous<br>"homesickness blues" later interrupted by a Charleston-like, highly rhythmic figure. Offenbach originally wrote the operetta's most famous number – the <i>Barcarolle</i> – for an earlier work <i>Die Rheinnixen</i> (1864) ir which it is known as the <i>Elves' Song</i> . In <i>The Tales of Hoffman</i> it appears as <i>Belle nuit, ô nuit d'amour</i> – a duet for soprano and mezzo-soprano in which they sing about the beauty of the night and of love. It is surely one of the most popular melodies ever written and its appeal endures today. |
